

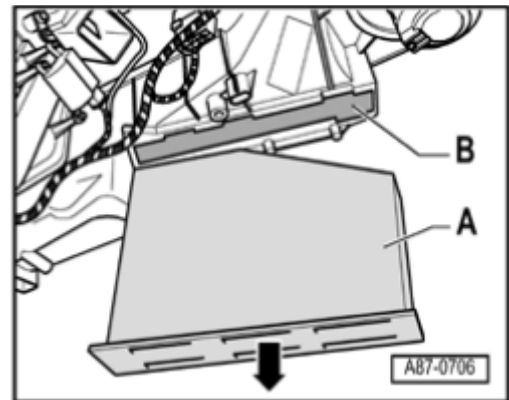

Washable, Reusable Cabin Air Filters

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PART NO. SP11800

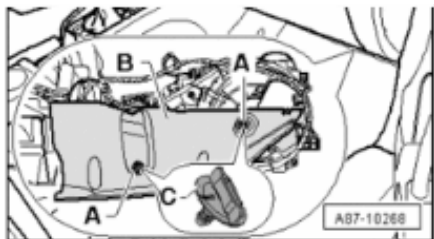
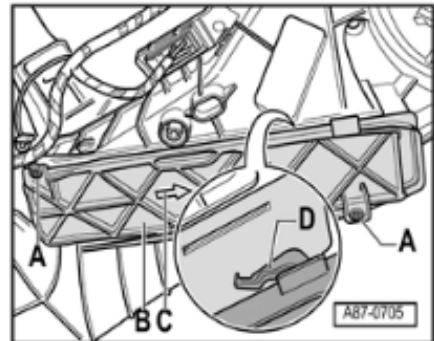
The cabin air filter is located under the dashboard on the passenger side
Installation time: 20 min

- Locate the filter housing cover
- Push and slide the cover to the right to remove
- Pull the old filter down
- Push the new Smart Parts Washable Reusable Cabin Air Filter up into the housing. Make sure to install it in the same orientation as the old filter (FIG 1) (squeeze to fit if needed)



Some car models may also require the following:

- FIG 2
 - Remove bolts (A) if necessary
 - Bolt (A) is not always present in all vehicles. Bolts secure the cover (B) when the catches (D) no longer hold
 - Push the cover (B) in the direction of arrow (C) and remove cover
- FIG 3
 - Screw clips (A) may have different versions, for example (C) and (D)
 - Remove filter element (A) from A/C shaft (B) or heater
 - Clean the area of dust, etc. in A/C shaft or heating before installing new filter
- Reverse the removal procedure to reassemble
